The launching ceremony of the HKMA CMS 3.0 and IT Expo were held on 28 August 2009. Professor Gabriel LEUNG, Under Secretary for Food and Health, was invited to be our Officiating Guest. Guests of Honor, Dr. John STRICKLAND, Chairman of the Information Technology Advisory Committee of the Hospital Authority, Mr. Victor LAM, Assistant Government Chief Information Officer (Business Transformation) of the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, Dr. CHEUNG Ngai Tseung, Chief Medical Informatics Officer of the Hospital Authority, Dr. CHOY Khai Meng, Consultant (Public-Private-Partnership) of the Food and Health Bureau, Dr. LEUNG Ka Lau, Member of the Legislative Council (Medical) and Mr. Carl YAU also joined us to officiate the ceremony. In addition, 6 recommended IT vendors presented their personalized packages to our members in the hall.

The HKMA CMS 3.0 software was in the form of DVD including documentation, source code and e-learning kit. They were distributed to members attending the ceremony. Interested members may also contact the Secretariat for a copy.

After the Press Conference last month, the TaoYuan team developed the enhanced HKMA CMS Wuhan version. The software DVDs distributed to members include both the standard version and Wuhan version for them to choose from.

The Launching Ceremony received an overwhelming response, over 200 members enrolled for the function. Due to the venue restriction, only about a hundred doctors could attend. In view of the over-subscription of the event, 2 more workshops on CMS 3.0 will be organized. The first workshop will be held on September 24 at the HKMA Wanchai Premises and the second one on October 17 (Saturday) at the MG Lecture Theatre in Queen Elizabeth Hospital. There will be demonstration on the installation and the functions of the HKMA CMS 3.0 together with FAQ Session. Interested members please refer to Circular 1519 for details and enrolment.

Since the HKMA CMS 3.0 is a very powerful software, installation may appear difficult to doctors. To better support our members on the use of the software and to celebrate the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the People Republic of China, the HKMA will sponsor free onsite installation of the software for 60 doctors together with one-month telephone support.
