

Information Technology (IT) Committee ~ *Dr. HO Chung Ping, MH, JP*

In December 2014, the eHealth Record Office (eHRO) of Food and Health Bureau approved a financial sponsorship of HK\$2,939,000 to the HKMA for improvement of the Clinic Management System (CMS) for the medical professional. The code name of the project is “Wenchang”.

The implementation of Wenchang project is comprised of two parts. The first part of the project would include technical development of the two systems, namely HKMA CMS Yuan Wang (YW) and HKMA CMS NuWa (NW) and their integration with Electronic Health Record Sharing System (eHRSS). In principle, the development of CMS YW system would be based on HKMA CMS 3X while the development of CMS NW would be based on the core framework of the Government’s CMS On-ramp. Both new systems would integrate with the Document Management System for scanning and management of patient documents.

The second part of the project includes technical support services for system installation, data migration, deployment and training for 200 private medical practitioners (PMPs).

It is expected that the project would be started at the end of first quarter of 2015. The whole project would take around 32 months for completion.

The Committee had put up the tender documents on our HKMA webpage for tender invitation on 18 December 2014. The IT Committee meeting was held on 22 January 2015 to evaluate and select the bidders. The contracts were finally awarded to Mobigator Technology Group on System Development and System Aid Medical Services Ltd on Installation, Deployment and Support & Training respectively. The Council approved to award the service contracts to these two vendors during the Council meeting on 3 February 2015.

The Committee is now working on the details of the contracts. We shall update members about the details of the project in the coming time.
